Wachusett Mountain offers an Instructor Training Course for those interested in becoming a ski or snowboard instructor or for experienced instructors interested in joining our team. Open to adult and junior skiers and riders. Juniors must be 16 years old by November 1, 2017.

BE PART OF THE EXCITING SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRY!

- Our Instructor Training Course (ITC) starts with Orientation Day from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on **Sunday, November 12, 2017** and continues each weekend thru mid-December. Orientation consists of talks, demonstrations and videos of the American Teaching System. Certified course conductors will be on hand to discuss procedures, class handling, training preparations and general information. This is not a national ski or snowboard association certification course but it is a necessary first step if that's your goal.
- You will face rewarding challenges and make new friends as you improve your skills and progress from skier/rider to Instructor. We teach the American Teaching System of the Professional Ski and Snowboard Associations of America.
- Training continues every Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. We will evaluate you in mid-December. Until that time, your course ID badge will admit you to all training sessions and also serve as an Unlimited Season Pass until evaluation day. This is one of the best training values available.

TERMS, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND CONDITIONS

1. I acknowledge that skiing/snowboarding is **HAZARDOUS** and that there are many **INHERENT RISKS** in these sports, including but not limited to variations in terrain, surface and subsurface snow, ice conditions, moguls, bare spots, forest growth, rocks and debris, lift towers and other obstacles and hazards. I acknowledge that snowmaking and snow grooming may be in progress at any time.
2. I have read and will obey the guidelines issued under the RESPONSIBILITY CODE as found on the Wachusett trail map and website. I agree to ski/ride in control and with care at all times.
3. In consideration for my or my child's use of the equipment or the resort facility, I agree, for myself and/or my child, to **RELEASE, forever indemnify, defend, and hold harmless** Wachusett Mountain Associates, Inc. & their owners, officers, directors, volunteers, employees, affiliates, agents and assigns, (collectively as "RELEASEES") from liability for any and all loss or damage to myself or to my child or my or my child's property resulting from the RELEASEES' **NEGLIGENCE** or any other cause. I understand that the RELEASEES are not responsible for the consequences of their own **NEGLIGENCE**, that is, their failure to use reasonable care in any way. I acknowledge that I am freely and expressly assuming and accepting any and all risks of property damage, personal injury and death in connection with my or my child's use of the resort, use of the rental equipment, and participation in skiing/snowboarding including instructional lessons. For parents/guardians of participants of minority age (under Age 18 at time of registration) this is to certify that I individually or as parent/guardian signing this agreement for the named minor, acknowledge and agree that I have read the above release of liability and that by signing this release on behalf of the minor.
4. This pass is for your personal use only. Transferring, improper use of this pass, or falsification of age will result in loss of privileges. **I understand that I may use my season pass only during times valid. Failure to adhere to this policy is considered theft of service.**
5. The season pass is the property of Wachusett Mountain Associates, Inc. and is revocable, without refund, due to misconduct or misuse as determined by Wachusett Mountain Associates, Inc. personnel.
6. There are no refunds for missed sessions due to weather or mechanical difficulties. There are no credits or refunds due to failure to pick up a season pass that has been pre-purchased. **Season Pass Insurance** (must be purchased when pass is ordered) provides pass replacement or pro-rated refund if pass cannot be used due to job, injury, illness or move. Any issues regarding the current season must be presented in writing no later than April 1st. NOTE: Insurance does not apply to Terrain Park Pass.
7. Night operating schedule may be limited during early or late season.
8. Season Pass does not guarantee admission during sellout periods. Limited Ticket Sale Policy: We strive to provide a quality skiing and snowboarding experience by limiting the number of tickets sold.
9. If a season pass is forgotten, pass holder will be required to purchase a full-rate lift ticket. Lost season pass replacement fee is \$50 without purchase of Pass Insurance. Return check fee \$25.
10. If renting equipment, I also agree that the same set of equipment will not be issued each visit and that the ski-boot-binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances.
11. I agree that this agreement will be governed by Massachusetts law. I also understand that if any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall be given full force & effect. I agree & understand that any claim or lawsuit against the RELEASEES may be brought in the federal or state courts of Massachusetts only.
